Important Note

Please attempt to upload *only* ADIF format log files. Your logs must contain at the very least the following:
DATE, TIME, CALL, MODE, and BAND or FREQ. Anything else is optional. (Note: Some logging software stores FREQ instead of BAND. If so, it will be automatically converted to a BAND designation for all valid amateur bands from 1800KHz to 300GHz.)
Other non-ADIF formats could corrupt your entire log! If you aren't sure if your log is ADIF format, use WordPad or NotePad (in Start/Programs/Accessories) to look at the .ADI file you are going to upload, and verify that it is in the format described [in this document](#).

Instructions

1. Break up your log into files of no more than around 1,000 records, to minimize the possibility of your browser timing out. You can [download a log file splitter](#) program that will split up your log file into multiple files of 1000 or fewer records.
2. Click the BROWSE button to select one log file on your disk.
3. Click the UPLOAD IT button to upload the file.
4. Now have patience and *WAIT* a few minutes. The task of converting the ADIF format into our database takes a while.


